INFORMATION FOR ATTENDEES

NAME BADGES: PLEASE BE SURE TO BRING YOUR NAME BADGE. IT IS YOUR TICKET OF ADMISSION.

Please wear it throughout the day. Should you lose your name badge or forget to bring it, obtain another at the CAIS Information Center in the Garver Gym. Please note that you might have to wait in line to retrieve another name badge, so it's best to hold on to the one included.

ARRIVING AND PARKING: The enclosed map gives directions to the Frankenstein Parking Structure of Universal Studios. From there you will ride a shuttle bus to Campbell Hall. **Allow 20 minutes to get from Universal Studios to Campbell Hall.** The first session begins at 9:30; you should be parked no later than 9:00.

PROGRAMS: Programs will be available at the CAIS Information Table in the **Garver Gym**. 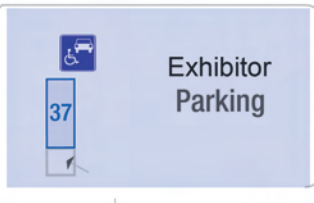

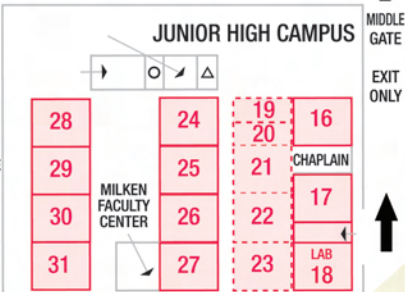

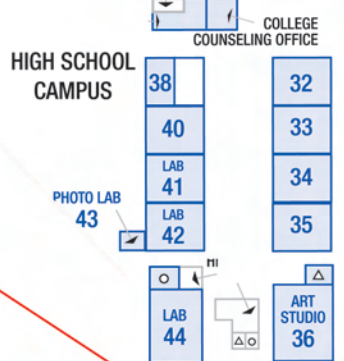

MAIN GATE ENTRANCE ONLY

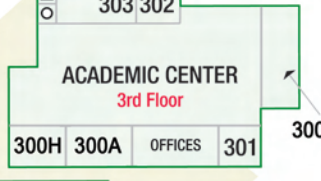

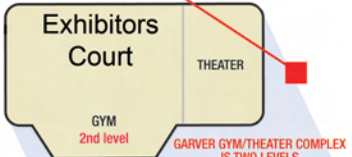

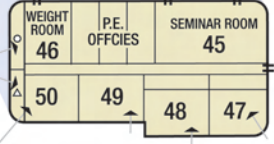

GARVER GYM/THEATER COMPLEX IS TWO LEVELS

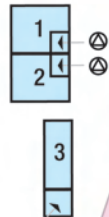
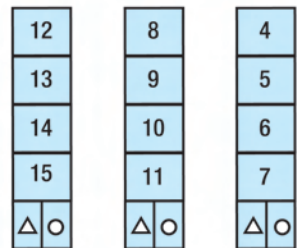

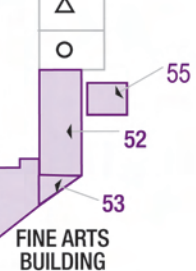
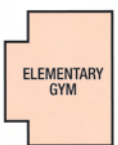

101 SOUTHBOUND (Coming from the West Side)

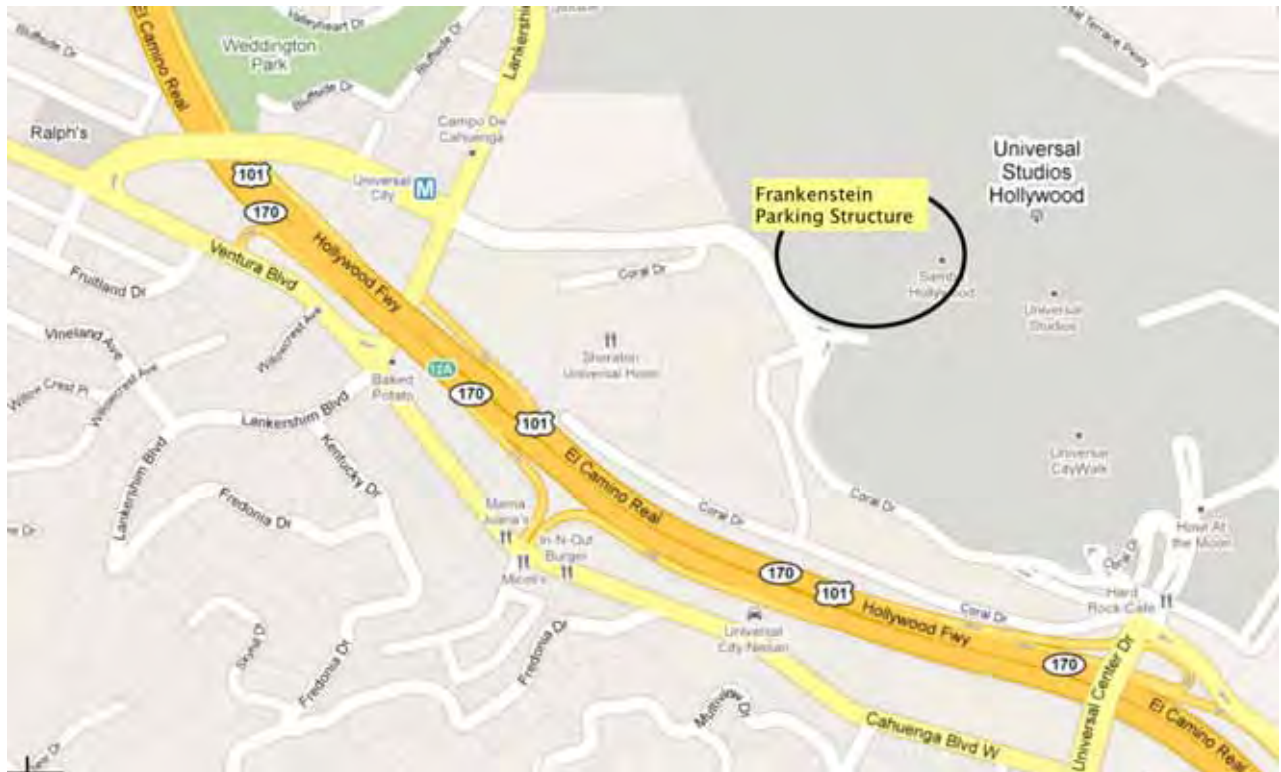
- Exit Lankershim Blvd. and turn right. (You will be on Cahuenga Blvd.)
- Go to Lankershim Blvd. and turn right.
- Go to Universal Hollywood Drive (at the electronic billboard) and turn right.
- Proceed up the hill staying in your left-hand lane. The Frankenstein Parking structure will be on your left-hand side across from the Hilton Universal Hotel.

101 NORTHBOUND (Coming from Downtown)

- Exit Lankershim Blvd. and turn right. (DO NOT EXIT at Universal Studios Blvd.)
- Go to Universal Hollywood Drive (at the electronic billboard) and turn right.
- Proceed up the hill staying in your left-hand lane. The Frankenstein Parking structure will be on your left-hand side across from the Hilton Universal Hotel.

FROM THE 134 WEST

- Exit Cahuenga Blvd. and turn left.
- Go to Lankershim Blvd. and make another left.
- Go to Universal Hollywood Drive (at the electronic billboard) and turn left.
- Proceed up the hill staying in your left-hand lane. The Frankenstein Parking structure will be on your left-hand side across from the Hilton Universal Hotel.



AFTER YOU HAVE PARKED YOUR VEHICLE

- Take the escalator to the 1st floor.
- Shuttle Signs will be located at the escalator lobbies pointing to the Shuttle pick-up location.

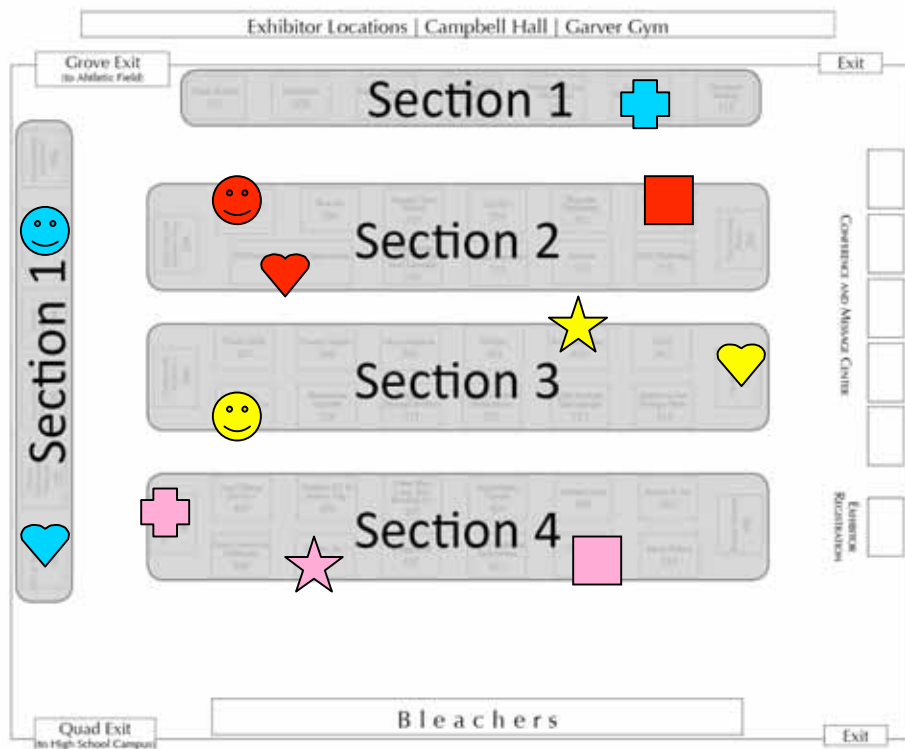
Raffle Rules:
